EQuIP is a registered Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) registered with the Charity Commission Number 1169436 on 30 September 2016. It currently has 8 trustees.

- 3. Establish and monitor policies including guidance for staff, systems for monitoring and reporting, an ethical framework for everyone connected EQuIP and conduct of trustees and board business
- 4. Set up employment procedures including recruitment, support, appraisal, remuneration and discipline and a wider role supporting volunteers.
- 5. Ensure compliance with the governing document
- 6. Ensure accountability to the Charities Commission, HMRC, donors, beneficiaries, and the general public
- 7. Ensure compliance with the law
- 8. Maintain proper fiscal oversight
- 9. Select, manage and support the Chief Executive
- 10. Respect the role of staff
- 11. Maintain effective board performance
- 12. Promote EQuIP

Meetings are usually held every 2 months in the evenings at a range of different venues across the County. There are also 4 sub committees including Finance, Employment, Fundraising and Community Insight & Marketing. We undertake annual elections for the roles of Chair, Vice Chair and Treasurer who have a number of additional responsibilities.

The post of trustee is unpaid but reasonable travel expenses will be paid.
