The movement had previously been middle class focused, whereas Pankhurst contributed to equality across a wider society, including women from middle and working class backgrounds.

The feminist movement in the U.K and parts of the Western world have gone through three waves, as mentioned above the suffragette movement was focused on political equality, whereas the second wave feminism attempted to challenge social and cultural inequalities. The third wave of feminism that exists today continues with addressing financial, reproductive and workplace inequalities.


